

# Argusville City Council Regular Meeting

May 7, 2013

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mayor Tandsater with the following in attendance: M. Howatt, R. Teberg, W. Hagemeister, D. Becker, Deputy Arth, Larry Carlson, Cheri Wetzel, Jeremy Denault, Russ Stoltman, Bob Westrick, Richard Atencio, Susie McDonald, Brandon Oye, Douglas Howard and Julie Tamble.

April Regular Meeting minutes and finance report were approved as read.

Mayor Tandsater reported on trailer park and presented bids for its curb stop project and for Lynn Dawn hydrant replacement.

M Hagemeister – S Teberg to accept the Agassiz Underground bids of \$9200 for the curb stop and \$5700 for the hydrant installation. Motion carried.

M Clouse – S Becker to authorize Al Woods to purchase hydrants. Motion carried.

Snow fence will be removed May 8. Hagemeister will handle Centennial culvert repair. Becker will handle mosquito control. Teberg will post No Dumping signs. Tim Keckler is assisting with the website. Atencio shared his elevator plans. Spring Clean up will be May 20. Wetzel reported on zoning. Flood expenses are in; Tandsater will check with Rogness about next steps. Deputy Arth reported on recent activity; discussion regarding four-wheelers in town.

Tamble and Howard, of Midnight Solutions Technologies, presented information about their internet company. M Hagemeister – S Teberg to support MST pursuing serving Argusville and report back to the city. Motion carried.

Oye updated on levee and re-plat projects. Public hearing for north Centennial and blocks 4, 5 & 6 must be held. Stoltman requested land price to share with the church and Diocese. Oye will work with the lawyer to put proposal together. The following motions carried unanimously:

M Teberg – S Becker to allow Shockley to draft purchase proposal with support from Moore Engineering.

M Hagemeister – S Becker to hold special meeting on June 11 at 7:00 PM.

M Becker – S Clouse to name plat projects Progress First Addition (north Centennial), Progress Second Addition (blocks 4,5,6) and Progress Third Addition (block 1&2).

M Becker – S Hagemeister to pay Moore invoice of \$1485.25 for levee plat work. Motion carried.

M Becker – S Clouse to pay bills: Cass Electric \$544.95, Cass County Reporter \$90.06, USPS \$51.15, Park \$1647.19, R. Teberg \$617.29, Ziegler \$348, Fleet Farm \$74.05, Century Link \$57.70, Cass Electric \$526.82, City of Fargo \$14, Metro Disposal \$2090, Cass Rural Water \$2775.46, Jared Kemmis \$47.60. Motion carried.
