

Argusville City Council Regular Meeting

September 7, 2021

Mayor Darren Wetzel called the meeting to order at 7:05 with the following in attendance: Dave Becker, Jenna Saewert, Katie Shipley, Mary Howatt, Deputy Thomas Behm, Mike Lovejoy, Justin Hall.

Wetzel opened the budget hearing. No comments from the community.

M Becker-Saewert to approve the final budget for 2022. Carried.

M Saewert- Shipley to approve consent agenda: August minutes, finance report, and bills to be paid: Cass County Electric \$590.80 & \$29, Cass County Reporter \$88.11, Office Depot \$96.85, Park District \$527.14, M. Hall presented engineer report. Still working n Richwood Estates Drainage Pond Easements and Lease Agreement. Presented priority ratings for web mapping options. Discussion. Hall will assemble proposal for next meeting. Discussed American Rescue Plan Act potential projects. Saewert requested city apply for funds; Howatt to complete.

The fire hydrant behind the county shop needs replacement. Hall will compile a data sheet for Wetzel to review. Recommended moving isolation valve closer to hydrant to meet current standard

Centennial Drive property update. Waiting for abstract completion. Will follow up with attorneys on progress.

Intelliplanz submitted Community Plan meeting for review.

Lovejoy plans to gravel roads Thursday if gravel will be delivered. Plans to gravel some additional areas. Discussed street light repairs on Northern Drive.

Discussed discovered cistern at city proper residence. City has no utilities there. The resident may fill it if they wish.

Saewert presented quotes for security cameras in town. Discussed quoted locations and additional possible spots in town. Saewert will invite Halstad representative to next meeting to answer questions and help assess what city needs are.

Becker to contact Fire Department about getting the burn pile done. Discussed school status and tax payments.

Saewert inquired about Apple Festival plans in the age of Covid. Discussed community activity options. She will prepare a mailing for this fall to announce plans for larger event in 2022.
