

# Argusville City Council Regular Meeting

**November 7, 2016**

Mayor Lyson called the meeting to order at 7:01 PM with the following in attendance: Dave Becker, Rod Clouse, Wayne Hagemeister, Mary Howatt, Justin Hall, Deputy Justin Mortenson, Jamison Jensen, and Kirk Howatt. Absent: Randy Teberg.

M Becker-Clouse to approve the October meeting minutes and finance report as presented. Carried.  
Deputy Mortenson reported on local activity.

Hall provided engineer update on original townsite water-sewer improvements. Manhole extension request for bids were sent out. Request special meeting on November 14 to review quotes and award contract. Substantial completion is set for November 25.

Levee Inspection was done within last month; waiting for action items. Hall will review and submit recommendation. Rodent work continues. Some televising work may still need to be done. Some vegetation on levee may need to be sprayed yet this fall.

M Hagemeister-Clouse to have Moore submit paperwork to remain on the Clean Water State Revolving Fund priority list. Carried.

Discussed abandoned vehicles at the elevator. Letter has been sent; no response. Deadline was November 14. Becker will work with Teberg to have items removed.

Long range planning discussed. Council requested an outline in December.

First reading of Ordinance 2016-8 for Water Rates and Charges. Discussed fees and timelines.

M Hagemeister-Clouse to approve first reading. Yay – Becker, Clouse, Hagemeister. Absent – Teberg. Carried.

Discussed sewer work done November 1 on Drake Avenue. Johnson to be reimbursed for televised line. Additional expense for repair to be coming.

M Clouse-Becker to bill deposit, S03, mosquito, and levee for 305 County Road 81 North. Carried.

Snow fence will be installed on November 9 on the north side of the original townsite. Yard waste collection will end for the season.
