

# Argusville City Council Regular Meeting

**November 2, 2015**

Mayor Tracy Lyson called the meeting to order at 7:04 with the following in attendance: Rod Clouse, Wayne Hagemeister, Randy Teberg, Jeremy Dewald, Jamison Jensen, Deputy Jeff Arth, and Mary Howatt. Absent: Dave Becker.

M Clouse-Hagemeister to approve October minutes. Carried.

M Teberg-Clouse to approve October finance report as presented. Carried.

Dewald provided update on Leonards 5<sup>th</sup> Addition water and sewer installation. The developers' agreement has been completed; the contractors are working at the site. Moore now has GIS capability if the city wants to set that up.

Hagemeister reported that Randy Moen has purchased Lako's road service. They looked at the route and had some concerns about manholes on Sugar Drive. Clouse will look at them and get quotes for correcting them this fall.

Hagemeister reported on progress at the school building.

Waste Management has changed our service day to Tuesday. Customer service issues are being smoothed out. Clouse brought truck fluid issues to WM's attention. Yard waste will be done November 9.

Clouse requested the city contact the highway department to remove bales in ditches at risk of plugging culverts.

M Teberg-Clouse to approve state insurance bond application. Carried.

M Teberg-Clouse to approve St. William's Men's Club gaming permit for 2/12/16. Carried.

Deputy Arth reported on local activity. Several street lights need bulbs replaced; need list of poles to submit work order. Discussed other street light issues in Richwood and potential need for additional poles. Check to see if NDDOT Transportation Alternatives Program funding is applicable.

Teberg noted vehicles from Johnson's former house have been moved to another residence in town. He will check on licensing before the city sends a removal letter.

Discussed concerns about property and road damage caused by 310 2<sup>nd</sup> Street residents.

Discussion about open burning outside barrels or pits. Lyson will check ordinances. Teberg will look into burn policies.

Discussion about replacement pump for lift station. Teberg will contact Al Woods.

M Clouse-Teberg to approve up to \$5000 for replacement if needed. Carried.
